We are a charity striving to eradicate the gender pay gap in the workplace by empowering girls to lead in the world's top industries.

We work with girls 13-18 to raise awareness and give them opportunities for leadership, and skills for their CV.

The girls - Youth Ambassadors - run events/activities that raise awareness of our website and get more girls signed up.

Our website connects girls to successful women working in a variety of jobs and gives them an insider's view of their day-to-day work lives. It also connects them to a range of companies in different sectors.

The Youth Ambassadors plan at least one event/activity per term and they follow a structured process as follows:

1. brainstorm and chose an idea
2. complete and submit a short templated plan to Modern Muse
3. create an action list with assigned owners
4. meet as required to ensure all actions are completed
5. hold the event/activity
6. conduct a review of the event/activity
7. feedback to Modern Muse

This structure enables girls to demonstrate they have followed a business process and have learnt important skills.

We provide a set of documents to assist the girls and also arrange for Mentor Muses to check-in and provide support by phone when required. The calls are arranged via a teacher.

The Youth Ambassadors should be able to hold their sessions with minimum teacher planning, although a sponsor teacher will need to facilitate.
